If you have never come before and would like to join us we would love to have you! Call Bonnie at 204-388-4795 for more info

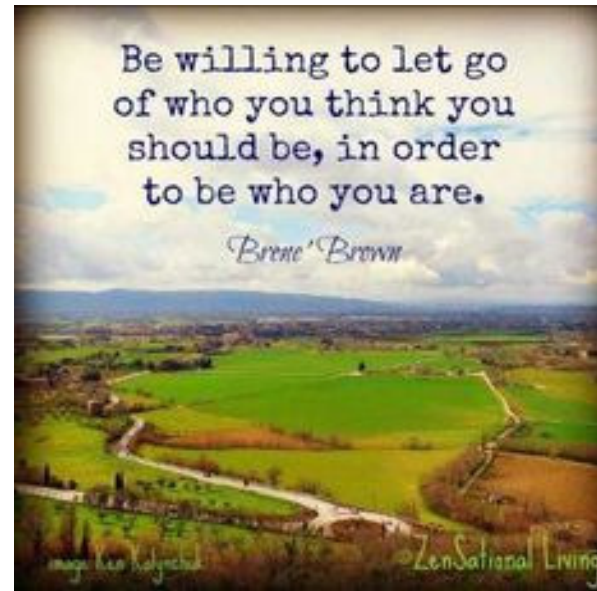
**Fellowship Night at the Berard's:** Every other Wednesday meet at Lucien & Wanda's home for a time of fellowship @ 6:30pm.
